


# Shickley Wins the All-School and Girls Class D NSAA Cup

On June 20, 2018 the NSAA announced the winners of the 2017-2018 NSAA Cup. This annual awards program recognizes the state's most successful high school athletic and fine arts programs, presenting awards to the 12 Nebraska high schools which earn the most points during the school year by participating in NSAA education-based activity programs. This all-activities (fine arts and sports), all-school recognition platform recognizes the "Best of the Best" each year in Nebraska sports and activities.

#### 2018 Seniors

Our seniors last year had the 3<sup>rd</sup> highest ACT scores in the state of Nebraska. Each year juniors participate in the NSCAS (Nebraska Student-Centered Assessment System) by taking the ACT.





# Did you Know?

- 62.5% of our teachers have a Master's Degree (54.92% is the state average)!
- 14.25 years: the average years of teaching experience at Shickley (14.03 is the state average)!
- Our pool provided 50 children with swim lessons and employed 7 high school and college-aged students!
- In 2018, our daycare brought in \$106,438.25 in revenue serving 56 children for 40 families!
- Our school provided Drivers Education to eleven 8<sup>th</sup>-grade-students at no cost to them or their families!
- SPS pays full tuition costs for our students enrolled in SENCAP courses!
- SPS pays full tuition costs for High Ability Learner students enrolled in dual credit courses!
- On average our three and four-year-old Preschool program has served 16 students each year, and for the next 3 years that number is projected to be 20 students!



### **Financial Information**


Being fiscally responsible to our patrons is something Shickley Public Schools takes very seriously. Just over 70% of our expenditures are going directly back into student instruction. As a rural Nebraska school, you can see we depend heavily on our local receipts in order to continue to make a positive impact on our students and community. Both the total levy and tax asking have shown consistent trends since the 2016-2017 budget.
