Business Items: President Lichti read a letter from the Shickley Education Association requesting that the Shickley School Board recognize the SEA as the negotiation representative of the teachers for the 2016-2017 school years. Mick moved and Schlegel seconded to approve the previously stated letter from the SEA. The motion carried 6-0 on a roll call vote. Kamler moved and Johnson seconded to accept the Nebraska Math Standards for Shickley Public School. The motion carried 6-0 on a roll call vote. Mick moved and Miller seconded to amend the 2015 school calendar by canceling school for Pre-K – 6<sup>th</sup> grade on Tuesday December 1<sup>st</sup>, 2015. Shickley will be hosting the District Play Production on that date. Mick moved and Johnson seconded to pay a bill to Erb Plumbing for \$10,753.72 for north gym bathroom renovations discussed at the last regular meeting. The motion carried 6-0 on a roll call vote.

Discussion Items: Mr. Ippensen gave the monthly Administrative Goals Update. He highlighted MAP testing and STAR testing results. Mr. Jorgenson briefed the board of a meeting held with the BD administration about a survey given to students about the possibility of adding additional athletic activities. The Negotiation Committee will begin the process of reaching a teaching contract agreement with the teachers by the February 8<sup>th</sup> deadline. The board discussed the outcome and purpose of the October 9<sup>th</sup> silent auction. The board also discussed future activity fundraising. The next regular board meeting will be November 9, 2015 at 5 pm. The NASB State Convention will be held November 18-20, 2015 in Omaha NE. The meeting was adjourned at 8:50 pm.
